

# Privacy Policy VSA Nijmegen

## How we respect your privacy

This privacy policy applies to information we (Vegan Student Association Nijmegen) collect about individuals who interact with our organization. It explains what personal information we collect and how we use it.

## 1 - Personal data that we process

VSA Nijmegen collects, stores and uses personal data for a variety of purposes. In the table in section 8, you can see the types of data we collect, store, and use, for what purpose, and the legal basis for why we are allowed to do so.

The following table explains the types of data we collect, store, and use and the legal basis, under current data protection legislation within the General Data Protection Regulation 2018 (GDPR) on which this data is processed.

In general, VSA Nijmegen aims to collect and process as little personal data as possible. Whenever feasible, we will collect data in an anonymised or pseudonymised form. However, you should be aware that it may still be possible (for people who know you) to figure out who you are from anonymised or pseudonymised data. This is especially relevant for #8 in the table in section 8: the member survey.

## 2 - How we use your data

When you supply personal information to us, we are legally obliged by the GDPR to ensure that the information you have provided is only used for the purpose for which it was intended, and to ensure that the data is stored securely. We will only use your data for the purpose it was collected for, as described in the table in section 8. To store your data securely, we use Google Drive.

## 3 - Who can see your data

Unless otherwise specified in the table in section 8, your data can only be seen by the current board of VSA Nijmegen. In some instances, we share data with third parties. Those are not included in the table, but are instead described in section 4.

## 4 - When we share your data

We do not share your personal data with third parties without your explicit consent unless it is necessary for us to do so. Usually when we want to share your data with third parties, we already asked for consent to share your data when we gathered the data. This may be done in the following situations:

- We share your data with the platforms where we store data. For example, event registration forms are stored by Google and we use MailChimp for our emails.
- We use SNS Bank for our finances. They can see your name, bank account number, when you paid your membership fee and when we pay you back for expenses made on behalf of the VSA.
- We may share pictures in which you are recognizable on our social media, like Instagram, on our website, or in our newsletter. Everyone can see pictures on our social media and on our website, and members can see the pictures in our newsletter. When we organize events in collaboration with other organizations, these pictures may also be posted on their social media accounts. One of these organizations is VSA Netherlands, who may also use our photos for promotional purposes.
- While this isn't a type of data that we process ourselves, when you join a WhatsApp group or we add you to a WhatsApp group, your phone number is implicitly shared with the other members of that specific group. For this reason, joining VSA Nijmegen WhatsApp groups is completely voluntary and optional. Note that WhatsApp (the company) can also see which groups you are a member of. Depending on your settings, WhatsApp may share this information with their parent company Meta.

The table in section 8 explains when we asked for your consent for the purposes specified above.

In case it is necessary for us to share your data for a reason not listed above, we will inform you immediately. If we would like to share your data, but it is not strictly necessary, we will ask your explicit consent before sharing the data.

## 5 - How long we keep your data

We take the principle of data minimization seriously. We will keep your data only as long as is necessary, and delete your data afterwards.

A detailed overview of when we delete your data can be found in the table in section 8. Note that, as described in section 6, if the table in section 8 says that processing of your data is based on consent, you can revoke your consent at any time. When you do so, we will delete your data as soon as possible.

## 6 - Rights you have over your data

The GDPR specifies a range of rights you have over your data. If you want to invoke these rights, you can send an email to [info@vsa-nijmegen.nl](mailto:info@vsa-nijmegen.nl) or contact one of our board members. These rights include, but are not limited to:

- When data processing is based on consent, you may revoke this consent at any time. You can use the link at the bottom of our emails to revoke consent regarding our newsletter. If you want to revoke consent regarding other matters, please contact us as specified above. Note that you can revoke your consent about specific data and specific purposes for which we use that data. For example, you can tell us you do not want your pictures to be used in future posts on Instagram, but that pictures that are already posted can stay online.

- You have the right to rectification as specified in Article 16 of the GDPR. If you want to correct information we process that is inaccurate, you can notify us and we will change it.
- You have the right to be forgotten as specified in Article 17 of the GDPR. You can ask us to delete information we process concerning you.
- You have the right to data portability as specified in Article 20. You can ask us to send you the data we store about you.

## 7 - Modifications

We may update this privacy policy from time to time. You can find the most recent version on our website. If a change we make meaningfully alters what data we store, what we use it for, or the rights you have regarding that data, we will notify the people who are affected.

## 8 - Detailed information

### How to read this table

**Purpose:** This describes what we use your data for. We will only use your data for the purpose that is specified here. If we want to use your data for any other purpose, that purpose will be included separately in this table. In case the legal basis for the new purposes is consent, we will have to ask your consent again for this new purpose.

**Data:** This describes what data we store and process for the specified purpose.

**Legal basis - Explanation:** This is why we are legally allowed to process the specified data. Article 6(1) of the GDPR describes 6 situations in which processing of personal data is legal.

**Who can see this besides the board:** This describes who can see this data, in addition to the board of VSA Nijmegen. When the table contains an “-”, it means only the board can see this data. Note that this table does not include third parties (like Google, SNS Bank or VSA Netherlands) we share data with as mentioned in section 4.

**When we delete it:** This describes when we delete your data at the latest. If the legal basis is consent, you can also ask us to delete it sooner, as specified in section 6.
